## Walk for Education

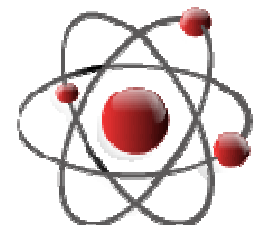
On the 16<sup>th</sup> of Oct 2009 Students , teachers and community members walked side by side in an innovative way to raise funds for the


